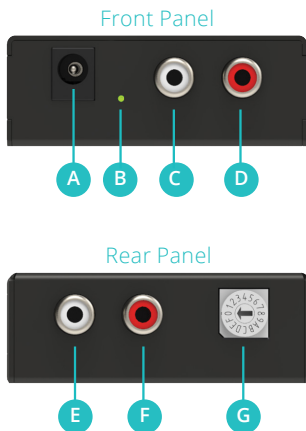

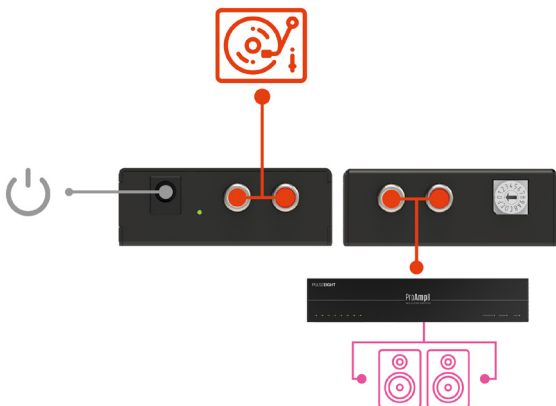

PANEL DESCRIPTIONS



- A DC 5V** - Use the provided power supply and connect to the device. Do not use any other power cables with this product.
- B PWR** - Power Status LED light.
- C Audio Input (L)** - Left input, connect to the output device (i.e audio matrix)
- D Audio Input (R)** - Right input, connect to the output device (i.e audio matrix)
- E Audio Output (L)** - Left output, connect to the input device (i.e amp)
- F Audio Output (R)** - Right output, connect to the input device (i.e amp)
- G Delay 20-340ms** - 16 Way Selector Dial to select the correct setting for the audio.

INSTALLATION



1. Connect the 'Audio Output' ports to the audio receiver (e.g. amplifier).
2. Connect the 'Audio Input' port to audio source (e.g. Bluray player).
3. Connect the provided power supply to the device. Other power cables should not be used with this product.
4. To achieve the desired delay, use a flat head screwdriver to adjust the position of the rotary switch. For more information, see the chart below. Take care not to turn the dial too quickly or harshly to avoid damage.
